**BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT AND RELEVANCE TO THIS CONTRACT**

Classical High School in Springfield, MA, was constructed in 1922 and vacated by the Springfield Public School system in 1981 and sold to a development group. After extensive analysis of the building, it was documented and converted into numerous unique condominium units so unique that there were over 40 different floor plans and one of the units had a staircase up to the former copper domed observatory, which was still functioning. The design team completed detailed as-builts and exhausting design documents reflecting the best use of the space without compromising the integrity of the extensive classical detailing in the building.
